Focus on Energy is inviting you to participate in a **free** pilot project seeking to address energy issues of your manufactured home.

Focus on Energy works with eligible Wisconsin residents and businesses to install cost effective energy efficiency and renewable energy projects. One of the Focus on Energy programs is Home Performance with ENERGY STAR®. This program works with existing homes to enhance their performance by making home improvements that are smart for both families and the environment. Home Performance with ENERGY STAR does this by incorporating testing and building science principles into home weatherization to maximize savings potential while increasing the safety, comfort and durability of the house.

Currently, the Home Performance with ENERGY STAR Program is working on a **special project involving manufactured housing**. As you know, manufactured housing is unique, having its own energy-related challenges. Some of these challenges include duct sealing and air leakage. Research studies have determined that duct leakage, *in most cases*, is the number one source of energy loss in mobile homes and a major source of comfort complaints.

Trained installers are prepared to test and close up the unwanted holes in your duct system, plus evaluate other energy-saving opportunities in your home. As a result of this evaluation, our installers may identify and fix other problems relating to energy efficiency that are cost-effective.

Because this is a pilot project, there is **no charge** to you. All we ask in return is that you sign a release form that will allow us to perform the work and obtain the following information:

- Records of your energy usage before and after the work is performed;
- Completion of a survey mailed to you six months after the work is completed; and
- Your permission to use your home's experience with this project (anonymously) in reporting the results to our administrating agency.
